2931 was to have been AVW400F.

2610-4 have appeared in a revised livery. The vehicles are painted cream with a wide green band above the windows and green mudguards, i.e. the bus livery reversed. The upper beading, previously painted green has disappeared as on newer FLF's and the beading around the central green band and below the windows has also been omitted. The area below the windows is now cream previously green. The fleetname has been modified to the standard coach fleetname i.e. forward sloping yellow capitals. Previous FLF coaches had plastic fleetnames in the top corner of the front lower panel. The luggage compartment has also been modified. The windows now extend to the rear of the vehicle and the last two windows on the lower deck which border the luggage compartment are finished with frosted glass. Frosted glass is also used for the two lower deck rear windows but the glass in the rear door remains clear. The vehicles have black blinds, cream interiors and revised seating-moquette. The U.W. is 8.17.1.
