The new joint services, which commenced on May 25th, are as follows:

- Service 1 London (Victoria) - Felixstowe
 Combination of E.C.O.C. A and Grey-Green 1
 Service 2 London (Victoria) - Bury St. Edmunds - Great Yarmouth
 (summer) Basically as E.C.O.C. P but with picking up points as per services 1 and 3. Also replaces E.N.O.C. X71.
 Service 3 London (Victoria) - Ipswich - Great Yarmouth
 Combination of E.C.O.C. F, Q, Grey-Green 3 and E.N.O.C. X70.
 Service 12 As present Grey-Green 12, summer only. Rerouted between Harwich and Colchester to parallel Essex Coast Express service 80. Also replaces E.C.O.C. QQ.
 Service 35 New Service: London (Kings Cross) - North London -
 (summer) Epping - Felixstowe/Great Yarmouth

Eastern Counties refer to these services as X1, X2, etc. All vehicles operating the services carry special 'East Anglian Express' labels.
