services. Bristol VR's 3115/18/25 are now operating for Western National as
1250/49/51 while 3216 has passed to Crown Coaches of Bristol as dealer for
re-sale.

BD small Mercedes 226/32 have Fare Clipper adverts on, while small Mercedes
are now scheduled for 251/551 evening journeys, commencing with service 551
18-30 ex Brentwood High Street (Mon-Fri) or 18-21 ex Bishop Hall (Sats).
Most buses at BD are now fitted with Yellow day-glow destination blinds,
first being noted February.

PD minibuses are semi-regular visitors to LT 193 and 362.

The first return journey in the mornings on service 2 (06-04 ex Hadleigh and
07-31 ex Redbridge) is a Minibus operation while the big bus is used on
service 20. The vehicles are swapped over at Southend Central Bus Station.
Sunday operation on services 2,3 and 20 from HH are all minibus operation.

The 350/1 extension in Romford operates via South Street, Oldchurch Road
and Rom Valley Road to the Tesco store at Roneo Corner.

The revised LT 362 operating between King Georges Hospital and Ilford Town
Centre commences on Saturday 20th March. Correct routing was listed in
January 93 Mag. To operate x20min Mon-Sat, but with x30min evening service
added. No Sunday operation.

A new £1 return fare is introduced from 8th March between Shotgate &
Wickford to Basildon after 9am Mon-Fri and all day Saturday.

Spotlight on Brentwood

From 15th February town services now require 10 minibuses for Mon-Fri peak hours and 8 Minibuses for off peak and Saturdays. There is extensive interworking of town services on Saturdays.

ESSEX COUNTY COUNCIL

Essex Sunday Savers are to be increased in price from 28.3.93. A family ticket is now £6.30, adult or oap is now £3.00 and a child is now £1.60.

For travel outside Essex a new Anglia Sunday saver is now available priced at £8.00 family, £4.00 adult, £3.30 oap, £2.50 child. These are valid on most buses in Essex, Bedfordshire, Cambridgeshire, Suffolk, Norfolk and Hertfordshire.

On both of these a family is a group of 4 maximum 2 adults, with child fares available for under 16s.

Sunday/Anglia Savers are not valid on Thamesway commercial services.

Lakeside Free Buses

The following commenced on 25.1.93. and are operated by Harris Bus using Bristol VRs.

L1 Brentwood (White Horse) 1000,1200,1400,1600 via Warley to Lakeside returning at 1120,1320,1520,1830. Journey time 35 mins.
L2 Dartford (Temple Hill Square) 1000, 1200, 1400, 1600 via Dartford Tunnel returning at 1115,1315,1515,1830. Journey time 30 minutes.

L3 Gravesend (Clock Tower) 1000,1200,1400,1600 via Northfleet, Greenhithe and Stone to Lakeside returning as per L2. Journey time 40 minutes.

L4 Redbridge (LT station) 0930,1230,1500 via Ilford, Dagenham to Lakeside returning at 1130,1400,1840. Journey time 55 minutes.

These services were revised from 6.3.93. with service L1 revised to operate via Horndon, L2 extended to serve Bexleyheath and Crayford and service L4 withdrawn. It is understood that a fare of £1.50 return is to be introduced from early April.
