33A 25/11/63	Certain journeys extended Mondays to Fridays from Dunmow, Post Office to Dunmow, Primary School, Rosemary Lane.
88B 24/9/63	New Tuesday service between Halstead and Countess Cross.
257 3/11/63	Certain journeys diverted Mondays to Fridays at Laindon, Fortune of War, to Basildon Town Centre. Saturday service withdrawn, covered by extension of 265.
265 3/11/63	Extended on Saturdays Only from Bulphan via Doesgate Lane, Dunton Wayletts, and Laindon, Fortune of War, to Basildon Town Centre to replace route 257. Gives through service Brentwood - East Horndon - Bulphan - Laindon - Basildon. Sunday service between East Horndon and Bulphan withdrawn.
302 22/10/63	Certain journeys extended on Tuesdays and Fridays from Stanstead (Park Road/Maitland Road) to Church Lane.
27/1/64	Journeys extended to Church Lane, Stanstead on Tuesdays and Fridays curtailed at Park Road/Maitland Road.
303 27/1/64	Service completely withdrawn, covered by diversions of routes 305/6. (Full details next month).
